While in Simpsonville, SC in a missions conference with Bible Baptist Church, our house was burglarized. Vandals from the neighborhood broke into our house. Our doors were terrible, just thin plywood and cardboard basically as we discovered when we took them out. They had to be replaced. So, we and many others prayed, and within a week, over two thousand dollars came in to meet the need! The doors and locks have since been replaced with steel doors and Primus dead bolts respectively, so, Lord willing, we won't be bothered any further with such nonsense.

Near the end of January, I took a solo trip up to Montana for some conferences I had up that way. God really blessed in the services. The preaching was tremendous and was greatly edifying to me. Plus, I made some great friends and gained some prayer support that will endure throughout our ministry.

The need for that prayer support was made very real to us as we lost two faithful prayer supporters over the last month. These dear ones are in heaven today but their place of prayer has been vacated. We are thankful for those everywhere who are stepping in to fill this "gap".

Pray for us in the busy months ahead as we travel and seek support. God has filled our schedule with only one week in late May (May 23 and May 27 in Florida) needing to be filled. Getting to where we need to be by the end of August so we can go to language school is unattainable for me, which means it is the perfect opportunity for God to step in and show Himself strong. Only He can do it, and I know He will, because He wants us in Uganda. We serve a great God, and I look to the day when our deputation ministry will be complete, and our lifelong ministry in Uganda will commence.
