Greetings! 2005 is already half done, can you believe it? So far, deputation is going well. I have been able to lead people to the LORD on outreach in various churches. I have seen men surrender to preach. God is using us, and that is very good.

We finished up BIMI candidate school in early June. The training we got this time around related more to being on the field, and less to deputation, all of which was most useful. It will be good to actually get to Uganda, so I can begin doing the things God called me to accomplish. 2005 is full up, and I'm working on 2006, so if anybody would like to have us in for a meeting next year, let me know.

Anna and the new young'un are doing well. He's a very active critter, which explains why we thought there might be two in there. If he's this active now, imagine how he'll be when he gets loose. Other than being hot all the time, Anna is doing fine. Pray that the rest of the pregnancy will go smoothly, that Gaelin will be born on time, and without complications. Pray that Anna's blood pressure will remain at normal levels, so they don't have to put her on magnesium sulfate (terrible stuff, makes you dizzy, and keeps you in the hospital longer). God has provided the means to cover this birth, however, so that's a great blessing.

The kids are doing well. They're enjoying deputation, which was our goal. We'll be spending most of July in Montana and South Dakota, so they'll get to see some of the West, Yellowstone, and the Rockies. We intend to make a sort of vacation out of it, which is to say, doing some sight-seeing when we're not going to meetings in the area. Looking forward to it. Be praying for the trip. It's quite a drive from here (St. Louis, MO), to there (Billings, MT and surrounding areas).

God has provided \$4450 towards the purchase of a new van. Those of you who have given toward this, THANK YOU so very much! We still need \$3750. Pray that the rest will turn up before we have to go to Montana, because we really need something bigger (more cargo and passenger room), and with air-conditioning (ours has none, and the heat is very hard on pregnant women, as well as little children).

Our support has remained unchanged. Please pray that God will move the churches where we've been to support us. Pray that I will succeed in filling up our 2006 schedule by the end of this year. Pray that God will put me in touch with the churches where He wants us to be, and that these will partner with us to get us to the field.

All told, things are going great, and we look forward to all God intends to do through us in the months ahead. God bless you all, and thank you for prayers and support.
