Greetings in the LORD! Summer is nearing it's end, and the beginning of our training at BBTI draws nigh. Our support is continuing to steadily increase, and things are on track for Fall and Spring of next year with meetings down in Texas. We're greatly looking forward to it. The schooling we receive will prepare us very well for the necessary task of learning the many dialects we will encounter on the field in Uganda, Africa. Failure to learn the language is one of the top hindrances that cripples the ministries of missionaries around the world. We will be learning how to conduct English-as-a-second-language classes, a handy tool in reaching the lost on the foreign field. You might not be able to get a Muslim to come to your church service, but you can get them to enroll in your English class, where you can then utilize any text you wish, say the Gospel of John perhaps? Most important, we will be learning how to translate the Bible, one of the things God has burdened us to do on the field. Pray for us as we transition to this next phase of our deputation ministry, that everything will go smoothly, and that we will both be very successful in our schooling, and be well prepared for the field.

Earlier this spring we were in a missions conference at Tulsa Baptist Tabernacle. The people there were a great blessing to us! A couple weeks ago God put us in touch with a couple from their church. Through this couple God provided most of the school books we will need through sixth grade!

During the month of July and the beginning of August we've been able to take a few weeks and attend our home church as we prepare for our move to Texas. During that time I was able to lead a man to the Lord after the evening service at our church! James, John and I, along with many others from our church, helped a new church in the area hand out Gospel of John and Romans in the neighborhood around their church. They've seen people attending because of this outreach. That, along with preaching in our church several times, has kept us busy.

Keep praying about our support. We would like to be mostly done with deputation by the time language school is complete. Mainly, we would just like to get to Africa and get busy doing what God has called us to do. Pray that more churches (and we have heard from some lately!) that were not able to support us at the time when we were with them, would be able to do so now so we can get our support raised more quickly. Continue praying that the funds we will need for outfit and passage will come in in time for our departure to the field, and that the money for housing and a vehicle will be there when we need it.

Thank you for sticking with us this far, particularly those of you who met us the earliest in our deputation ministry. God has blessed us, and the end is in sight!
